We will be playing a wide game on the Friday evening and enjoying a campfire on Saturday evening. After you cook breakfast on Saturday morning, we'll take a short walk to Harmer Green to light fires and cook lunch over the fire. There's a fun challenge on return to Datchworth before cooking our dinner. On the Sunday we will be striking camp and we will probably take part in some field games or challenges too. Your Scout Leaders will help you decide what to take to camp and help you plan your menu and shopping list over the next few Troop evenings.

Patrols can be any size up to 7 Scouts (ideally with a minimum of 3 or 4 Scouts). Patrols will need to supply their own camping kit (tents, stoves, cooking set, camp furniture etc.). A suggested kit list will be provided. Each Patrol will need to plan a menu and bring your own ingredients, but your leaders and parents will no doubt help with this. The menu should be balanced, filling and suitable for all members of your Patrol. Meal details are as follows:

Friday supper:	Supplied by District (hot dog)	Saturday dinner:	2 courses, main must be hot
Saturday breakfast:	Free choice, ideally something cooked	Sunday breakfast:	Free choice, ideally something cooked
Saturday lunch:	Supplied by District (on fires)	Sunday lunch:	No cooking (sandwich/rolls etc.)
