District Scout Adventure Day Saturday 29th June 2019 – The Canyon Final Arrangements

9:30am Saturday 29th June, Stevenage Scouts Activity Centre, The Canyon, Valley Way, SG2 9AF. Please check-in and collect information on your activity session times. You will need the kit listed below and a **packed lunch**. Squash will be provided. There is a car park adjacent to the Pear Tree pub, another opposite at the shops or in Valley Way itself. If there isn't sufficient car parking, you can also park at the 'Show Ground' and walk across the field to the Canyon.

4:00pm Saturday 29th June, Stevenage Scouts Activity Centre, The Canyon, Valley Way, SG2 9AF. Please arrange to be picked up from here after you have signed out.



Activity groups are arranged before the event to ensure an efficient start (maximising on activity time). It will not be possible to change groups on the day. **You may e-mail Neil no later than Thursday 27th June, using the e-mail address above to suggest another Scout attending who you would like to be in the same group as yourself.** We will do what we can to accommodate your request, but this can't be guaranteed. We always try and put Scouts from the same Scout groups together. Please don't ask to change groups on the day.

We will aim to provide about an hour of each activity; climbing/abseiling, shooting, leap of faith/Jacobs ladder and crate stacking. Activities may have to be adapted if the weather is unsuitable but we will do everything possible to ensure you have a good day! A 45 minute break will be provided for you to eat your **packed lunch (which you must supply!)**. Please do not plan to leave the Canyon at lunch-time. If the weather is bad, we will eat in the building.

It may also be possible to include the new zip-wire if we have time and sufficient instructors.

The following kit will be required:

- Please arrive in suitable activity clothing for the weather (not uniform), but **wearing your Troop Scarf.**
- Footwear needs to have a full sole, i.e. trainers or walking shoes. No sandals or crocs.
- Packed lunch and drink.
- A waterproof jacket.
- Sun cream & sun hat.
- Suitable bag to carry your kit in!
