You do have the right to see any information held about you or your child. If this is the case, please apply in writing to your ADC or DC.

District Cub Activity Day 13th July 2019

Canyon Activity Centre and Fairlands Lakes

This will be an opportunity for your Cubs to take part in adventurous activities both on and off of the water. The morning session will start at 9am, so booking in will be from 8:30am. Afternoon session will start at 2pm, and therefore booking in will be from 1:30pm. Cubs do have the option for staying the whole day. If they are attending the District Camp then as part of the Getting to Know you camp they will have the whole day taking part in the activities.

Children will be able to choose between different activities, though if they will need to base themselves at one location during each of the morning and afternoon sessions.

A packed lunch will be required by all children who are staying for the whole day, however drinks will be provided, though water bottles are suggested.

Picking up and dropping off will be from the Canyon and will be at 12:30pm for morning session and 5:30pm for afternoon session and whole day.

Children taking part in the Bournemouth Camp sleepover will then be walking to the District HQ at Poplars, where all of the sleeping kit and bags will be taken to.

Change of clothes and towel needed for all Cubs taking part in the water activities in a named separate bag.

District Cub Camp to Bournemouth

Getting to know sleepover on 13th/14th July, drop off at the Canyon and collect from District HQ, Poplars. Parents meeting at midday on the Sunday

Sun 11th - Sat 17th Aug. at Butchers Coppice Campsite

This is a fantastic chance for the cubs to take part in the District Camp on a delightful campsite near Bournemouth. The site is packed full of a variety of activities, such as climbing, trampolines, trim trails, crate stacking, etc. The cost of £235 will include all meals, activities, accommodation and travel there, whilst there and return journey for the 7 day camp, as well as the meals, activities and accommodation on the 2 day getting to know you camp starting at the Canyon and finishing at District HQ, Poplars

Sunday, travelling up, stopping at an attraction on the way. Monday, a trip to *Moors Valley Country Park*, a large woodland playground, some structures being over 5 metre high, followed by a *Narrow Gauge Railway* trip. Tuesday, a boat trip to *Brownsea Island*, birthplace of Scouting, followed by a boat trip around *Poole Bay*, that night there will be a chance to go *swimming*. Wednesday, a morning playing *laserquest* followed by the afternoon on the *beach*. That night there will be a *campfire* for everyone on site. Thursday, a day at *Blandford Army camp* where they will be taking part in the *Spies and Codes tour*. In the afternoon they will be using some of the leisure facilities at the camp. Friday, will be a chance to go to the *Adventure Wonderland*, the cubs will have unlimited ride passes to go on the pirate ship, The World of the wild thing, mazes, runaway train, space orbiter ride, adventure playground, etc. Saturday, will be finishing off the camp with some activities on the field, before packing away to come home. On one evening they will be out for a *restaurant meal*.

Evening activities will involve a party, cinema, disco, on site activities (rifle shooting, crate stacking, trampolining, orienteering, archery, climbing, etc.), and a camp fire.
