District Scout/Explorer Shooting Competition Saturday 17th June 2023 at The District Activity Centre, The Canyon

Calling all Scouts and Explorers for a day of competition and activities at the Canyon.
In addition to the shooting we will be offering:



Climbing / Abseiling, Crate Stacking

The day runs from 9:00 am through to 4:30pm with a break for lunch (bring your own packed lunch) and costs £15.

To take part, please complete the two forms (general permission and shooting consent) and return with your payment by no later than Monday 12th June 2023. The forms and payment can be returned via your Scout leader, to the Scout shop at Poplars on Monday evenings between 7:30 and 9:00pm (please use an envelope and label for the attention of Jack Jeffreys) or via post to the address above. More details and a kit list can be found below. Due to the number of participants allowed on some of the activities places will be limited and will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.

Arrangements for the day

9:00 am Saturday 17th June, Stevenage Scouts Activity Centre, The Canyon, Valley Way, SG2 9AF. Please check-in and collect information on your shooting and activity session times. You will need the kit listed below and a **packed lunch**. Squash will be provided. There is a car park adjacent to the Pear Tree pub, another opposite at the shops or in Valley Way itself. If there isn't sufficient car parking, you can also park at the 'Show Ground' and walk across the field to the Canyon.

4:30 pm Saturday 17th June, Stevenage Scouts Activity Centre, The Canyon, Valley Way, SG2 9AF. There will be a short prize giving. Please arrange to be picked up from here after you have signed out.

We will aim to provide 2 one-hour sessions of activities and 3 ½ hours of shooting. The competition will comprise of Air Rifle, Air Pistol and Field Target shooting; alongside a knockout competition. There will be a 1 hour induction session to let you practice with all the different types of gun. Activities may have to be adapted if the weather is unsuitable but we will do everything possible to ensure you have a good day! A 45-minute break will be provided for you to eat your **packed lunch (which you must supply!)**. Please do not plan to leave the Canyon at lunch-time.

Suitable activity clothing for weather (not uniform), but wear Troop Scarf .	Footwear with a full sole (trainers or walking shoes). No sandals or crocs.	Packed lunch and drink.
A waterproof jacket.	Sun cream & sun hat.	Suitable bag to carry your kit in!
